- ❖ Requests for up to \$500 will be considered for classroom projects supporting the mission of AAUW (to advance gender equity for women and girls through research, education, and advocacy.)
- ❖ Projects for funding will apply to N-12 levels in any area of public school education.
- ❖ Application dates are rolling, i.e. apply at any time. The committee will review the proposal and decide if it is to be presented to the Board of Directors for funding. Applications should be submitted to PO Box 894, Cheektowaga, NY 14225 at least 60 days before the project is to begin. All applications will be acknowledged.
- ❖ Projects should take place in the 8 WNY counties.
- ❖ Applicants for selected projects will receive written notification, at which time the funds will be awarded and the project may begin. At the conclusion of the project, receipts for materials should be submitted up to the amount agreed upon and any surplus funds returned. A brief final report should be included.
- ❖ Applicants for projects not selected will be notified in a timely manner.
