

American Association of University Women Buffalo Branch, Inc. Jacquie Walker Scholarship



Guidelines:

- **Materials (recommendations, transcripts and applications) must be postmarked or received electronically by February 13, 2026. Applications submitted online must have an e-signature.**
- Up to two merit-based scholarship awards: each in the amount of \$5,000.
- At the time of application (i.e., in February), applicant must be a full-time undergraduate or graduate student attending an accredited college or university; proof of enrollment required to receive award.
- Applicant must be a Western New York resident. Applicant does not need to currently study at a WNY institution. However, the applicant must have lived in Western New York prior to attending college and graduated from a high school in Western New York or have been home schooled in Western New York. The counties of Western New York are Erie, Niagara, Orleans, Genesee, Wyoming, Chautauqua, Cattaraugus, and Allegany.
- Applicant must demonstrate a strong commitment to community service and dedication to academic achievement..
- Applicant must submit two letters of recommendation. The letters must include the name and school of the applicant plus the name, phone number and position of the recommender.
 - 1) One must be from an academic advisor, professor, or mentor who can attest to the applicant's academic achievement
 - 2) One must be from a person familiar with the applicant's community service activities and provide an evaluation of the applicant's dedication to community service.
- Applicant must obtain official transcripts of **all** colleges attended since high school graduation.
- **Letters of recommendation and transcripts may be sent in one of two ways:**
 - 1) Recommenders and colleges may send the documents directly to our address or email address.
 - 2) You may obtain SEALED original letters of recommendation and transcripts and you may send those sealed along with your application (in a single envelope). This gives you the greatest control over the receipt of your application and supporting materials.
In either case, the applicant is responsible for ensuring that the documents are received by the deadline. Late or missing materials will disqualify the application.
- Applicant must write a 1-page essay discussing why community service is important to them and how they plan to continue service to the community in their future.
- Applicant must list student activities and a brief description of the leadership role played in them. Include what you find most rewarding or valuable about your participation in these activities.
- Applicant must list community involvement and a brief description of the benefits received from it and must list awards and honors received.
- Applicant must attend a personal interview if requested to do so.
- Applications and supporting documents must be received by the deadline. It is applicant's responsibility to send or mail in time and to ensure that all transcripts, references, etc. are sent in time to meet the deadline. Applications postmarked after the deadline will not be accepted. It is highly suggested that applicants send or mail materials *at least two days prior to the deadline*.
- Awards will be announced by mid-April and presented after receiving confirmation / proof of enrollment.
- All applications must be computer printed using at least a 12-point font. Handwritten applications will not be considered.
- Previous recipients of the Jacquie Walker scholarship are ineligible.
